Catharine has worked in the mental health field for the past 16 years. She has held a number of positions with the Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA), at both national and provincial levels. From 2003-2007, Catharine was the Director of Policy and Research with CMHA BC Division and oversaw a number of initiatives including a homeless outreach project; a police-mental health system initiative and a peer support initiative within the child and youth mental health sector.

Catharine has evaluated community-based mental health systems in a number of BC communities. Most recently, she worked as a Program Director with the Vancouver Foundation where she was responsible for developing and implementing a roadmap for the Foundation's focus on homelessness. Catharine has a Masters of Health Science from the University of Toronto and a certificate in conflict resolution from the Justice Institute of British Columbia.
